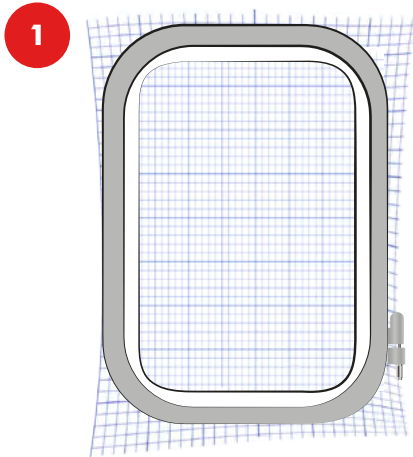
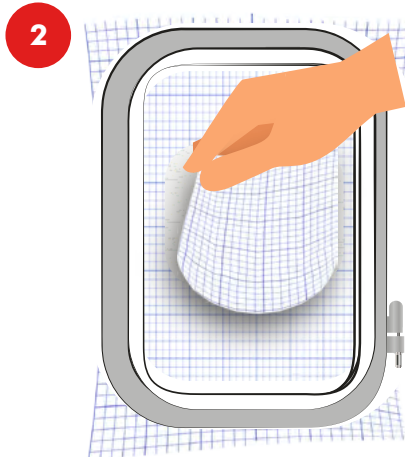


# How to do MultiStitch Embroidery ASLAN ME 70



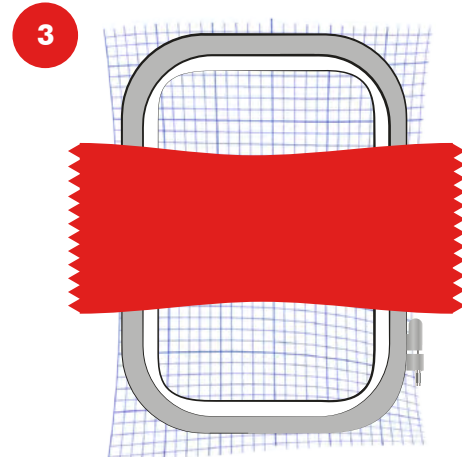

Stretch ASLAN MultiStitch Embroidery tight and without wrinkles into the hoop with the backing facing up.



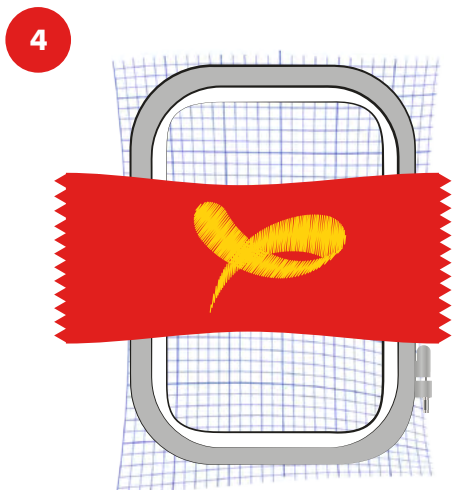

Cut the backing with a needle or a cutter without damaging the film.



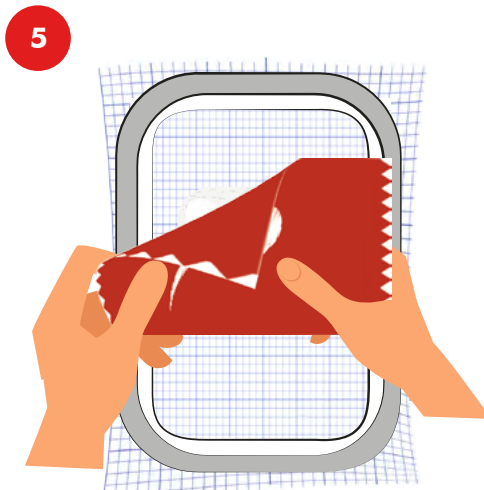

Apply textile onto the adhesive and press firmly.



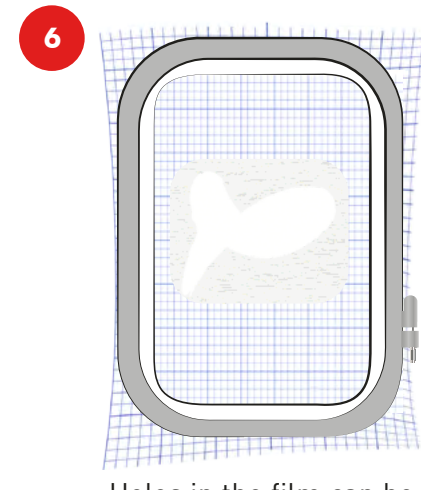

Embroider the textile.



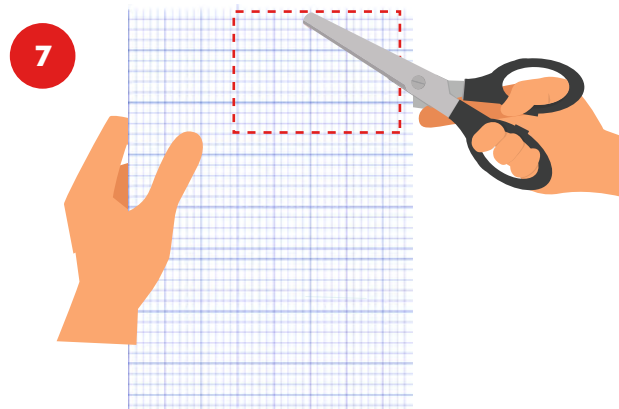

Tear off or cut off the textile carefully together with the spent ASLAN MultiStitch Embroidery.



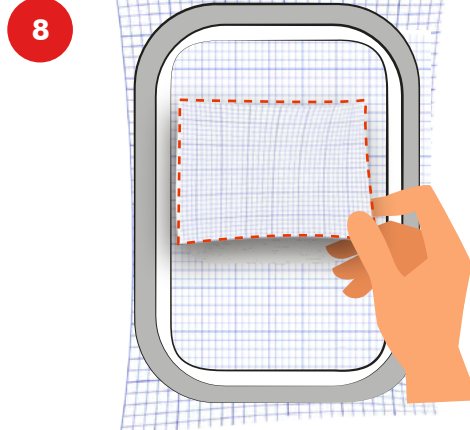

Holes in the film can be filled with another piece of ASLAN Multistitch Embroidery or the backing.

For that purpose cut a piece of Multistitch Embroidery or use a backing waste.

Apply that piece with the backing facing up onto the hole and you are ready to start again.
